Rectangular document, bifolio, A3 size, with handwritten and printed text. At the top, it bears the heading: "REAL CASA DE MONEDA DE LIMA" (Royal Mint of Lima), and on the sides, two different seals; on the left side, the coat of arms of the Spanish crown (Ferdinand VII) and on the right side, the seal of the Royal Mint of Lima. On the lower left side there is a red stamp: "MINISTRY OF FINANCE / 1821 / HISTORICAL ARCHIVE" ("MINISTERIO DE HACIENDA / 1821 / ARCHIVO HISTORICO"). On the left side there are some printed and handwritten notes: "Silver Payment Certificate (*Certificado de libranza de plata*), / Lima, 13 July / 1820 / for 6,000 Marcos. / Worth 51,000 pesos. It contains the signatures of at least eight (8) officials, including Count San Juan de Lurigancho, Ignacio Antonio Alcázar; Pablo [Terán], Ignacio Caveró, Juan ..., de Rosas, Pablo Cano de Melgarejo; (For the Faithful) Martín de Caveró, Ignacio Ayllón Salazar (scribe of the Royal Mint). On the reverse side, the following is written in manuscript: "Certification of Item 42 / of 6,000 silver marks (illegible) / Issued on 13 July / 1820", below the abbreviation "TriPLICATE". The document consists of a certification of a payment certificate and the enclosure of six thousand silver marks reduced to currency, specifying the laws (purities) and the type of coin minted. It is signed by the Accountant of the Royal Mint of Lima, Don Ignacio Caveró y Tagle, of the Order of Alcántara, and by other officials. Fair condition, with rust stains from iron gall ink (especially in the handwriting), irregular edges and small creases, as well as ink migration to the reverse side, causing corrosion.

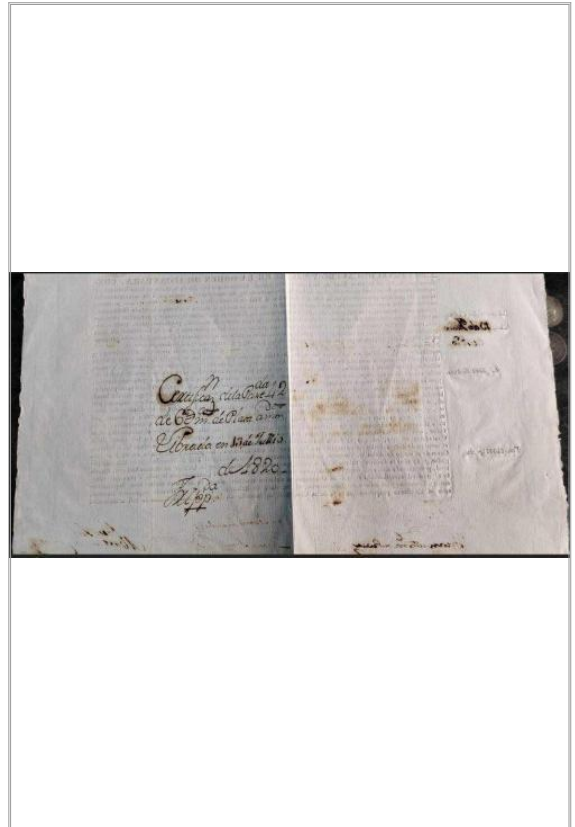
